

The GLOBE Program U.S. Partner Regional Ambassador Committee

1.0 NAME AND PURPOSE

1.1 The GLOBE Program U.S. Partner Regional Ambassador Committee (US-PRAC), formed in January 2011, is an advisory body organized exclusively for the GLOBE Program. The purpose of the advisory body is to provide the GLOBE Program Office with a formal mechanism for community input regarding U.S. implementation activities. The GLOBE Program U.S. Partner Regional Ambassador Committee is established for advisory purposes and does not hold binding authority for activities of the GLOBE Program.

1.2 The GLOBE Program U.S. Partner Regional Ambassador Committee will:

- Provide community input to the GLOBE Program Office on implementation policies, activities, opportunities and priorities in the U.S. prior to approval by the GPO Board;
- Provide community input and assistance relating to all implementation aspects of the GLOBE Program in the U.S.;
- Elevate implementation-related community issues in the U.S. directly to the GPO; and
- Report on and share information on GLOBE Program U.S. implementation activities, opportunities and priorities with the GPO and other partners across the U.S.

2.0 MEMBERSHIP

2.1 Membership of the Committee will consist of ten to fourteen representative members selected as in 2.2 below, plus the North America GLOBE International Advisory Committee (GIAC) representative and the GLOBE Program Office International Division Director as Ex-Officio committee members.

2.2 Members can be nominated, invited, or otherwise selected to represent a range of GLOBE Partners across the U.S.

2.3 Membership terms will be for two years, with the opportunity to serve one additional 2-year term. Members of the inaugural committee will be serving the second year of their first term in 2012.

2.4 Subcommittees may be formed based on topics of interest to the GPO and to the committee. Each year, subcommittees will be revisited, revised or terminated as appropriate. Chairs of subcommittees must be in at least their second year of service on the US-PRAC.

3.0 MEETINGS

3.1 The GLOBE Program U.S. Partner Regional Ambassador Committee will meet quarterly each year, with at least one face-to-face meeting.

4.0 OPERATIONS

4.1 The GLOBE Program Office will support the operations of The GLOBE Program U.S. Partner Regional Ambassador Committee including the preparation of Agendas, Notes of Meetings, and any travel arrangements.
